





#### **EDUCATION**

Below is a sample of the Education Projects MKT has completed.

#### BCIT, AEROSPACE CAMPUS

A 300,000 sf building sited on a sensitive river front location, and accommodating a 40,000 sf hangar, classroom, shops, fitness room, library and cafeteria. Also included, a 90,000 sf private sector office building capable of future conversion to classroom and lab space to accommodate future industry partners. The result was a leading edge architectural building delivered well below current market costs, with all program space included.





# UNIVERSITY OF OTTAWA SPORTS COMPLEX

A \$35 Million Sports Complex and Parkade located on the campus grounds at the University of Ottawa. The complex includes: two N.H.L. sized ice rinks; a large fitness centre; sports medicine clinic; squash courts; retail space; offices; classrooms; an artificial turf playing field; a second floor sports restaurant/ lounge/bar overlooking the ice arenas and playing field; and an attached 538 car multi-level parkade. MKT developed the business plan and provided full project management to successfully complete the project for the university.

# SAIT TRADE & TECHNOLOGY COMPLEX

A 400,000 sf campus redevelopment comprised of four new buildings, demolition of an existing parkade, demolition of existing academic buildings, and creation of temporary buildings to house relocated classroom spaces. MKT provided project management services for infrastructure and pre-construction





### UBC MULTI-TENANT FACILITY

A high-tech facility developed by Discovery Parks Inc. (a U.B.C. affiliated company) on the grounds at the University of British Columbia in Vancouver, B.C. MKT provided services as Development Advisors to the client throughout the entire process.

### LANGARA COLLEGE LIBRARY

Langara College wanted to develop a new 80,000 square foot library/classroom facility as well as a 450 stall parking garage on its Langara campus situated in the City of Vancouver. MKT provided full project management services.



#### UNIVERSITY OF REGINA UNIVERSITY CENTRE

The \$28.4 Million new home for Visual Arts, Theatre, Student Services and the Student Union Centre has been developed for the University of Regina. This multi-use facility, situated at the south west entrance to the campus, was designated as a new centre of student activities as well as a gateway into the University. MKT provided full project management services.





### SAINT THOMAS AQUINAS

A 7,525 square metre, four storey vertical high school set on a steep site. the project was required to be integrated within an existing campus footprint. MKT provided full project management services working with a volunteer building committee to successfully complete the project in a challenging construction environment.
